1.) In his second letter, which was written to a lady, John wrote: "And now I beseech thee, lady, not as though I wrote a new commandment unto thee, but that which we had from the beginning, that we love one another. And this is love, that we " (2 John 1: 5-6)
2.) Jesus said, "A new commandment I give unto you, that ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. By this shall if ye have love one to another." (John 13: 34-35)
3.) Jesus said, "This is my commandment, that ye love one another, as I have loved you. Greater love hath no man than this, that a man" (John 15: 12-13)
4.) To the Romans Paul wrote: "Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honour one another; Not slothful in business; fervent in spirit; serving the Lord." (Romans 12: 10-11)
5.) The writer to the Hebrews said, "Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised); and let us consider one another to not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching."
